

DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS ADMISSION POLICY
OUTSTANDING SPORTSPERSONS 2019-20

Following are the criteria to be followed for candidates who wish to apply through Sports Quota:

1. Candidates need to apply, pay application fees and meet the necessary admission criteria. If an admission test is prescribed for the course applied for, the candidate is required to appear for the same.

2. Candidates who meet the following requirement and have sporting achievements *IN THE LAST TWO YEARS* in the listed sports/games, are eligible to report for Document Verification on date specified below:

4th June (10:00 am to 1:00 pm)

- Played at the State / National/ International level for tournaments conducted by the State/National/ World Associations of that particular sport.
- Played Cricket, Basketball at the 1st/2nd Division level in tournaments conducted by Cricket Association of Bengal/ West Bengal Basketball Association.

3. Following documents are required, of which, originals will be verified and photocopies retained by the University:

- Photocopy of University application form with photograph and Application Fee Bank Receipt.
- 2 Passport size photographs.
- Class XII Marksheet.
- Certificates of sporting achievements of last two years meeting the above criteria.
- Ranking proof wherever applicable. (e.g. for Chess, Tennis etc).
- Identification Card of the Association. (Cricket Association of Bengal, West Bengal Basketball Association etc).
- Letter of proof from the 1st/ 2nd Division Club a candidate has played for in the last two years with a list of performances.

4. Candidates found eligible will be issued a Trial Slip and will report for trials/ interviews

The trial also includes a physical fitness test

5. A candidate placed first or second in any trial may not be shortlisted for admission. Performance at par with the current University / State level or if deemed necessary, University standard is an important criterion. There can be a second or third trial if required.

6. List of shortlisted candidates who are to appear for an interview with the Vice-Chancellor, will be posted on the University Web site. Date of announcement of shortlisted candidates will be on the trial slip of the candidate or on the University Website.

7. Final Selection of a candidate depends solely on the discretion of the University Vice-Chancellor.

8. A student selected on the Sports Category would need to sign a contract with the University which would bind the student to a set of rules and regulations failing which the student may be removed from the Rolls of the University.

9. Candidates falling short of the cut off marks required to apply to the University will be allowed to meet the Vice- Chancellor, with all the aforementioned documents on the date notified on the Web site. Candidates found eligible may be allowed to apply. All other Admission rules remain the same for students applying through the Sports category.

10. A candidate reporting late will not be allowed to appear for the trials.

11. The University reserves the right to cancel an application of a candidate on grounds of misconduct of the applicant.

12. Trials are conducted on and off the Campus; dates and venues of which can be rescheduled due to any unforeseen circumstance.

13. Admission to any course is the sole discretion of the Vice-Chancellor.
